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THE AMETEK (APT) QUALITY COMMITMENT

AMETEK APT has a Quality Assurance System that complies with the requirements of ISO9001: 2000 and is in place for both our Clawson and Peck Michigan facilities. Excerpts from our Quality Assurance System Manual are included in this document for reference only; the complete Quality Assurance System Manual is made available to our customers of record.

Ametek APT has been 3rd party certified and audited annually by EECS (Electrical Equipment Certification Services), recognized as BASEEFA (British Approval Service for Electrical Equipment in a Flammable Atmosphere), from 1996 through 2002, at which time the EECS offices were closed. Our license was granted under the terms that our Quality Assurance System complied with ISO9002 standards, as well as meeting all special EECS Quality Assessment Schedule criteria. We have always maintained an acceptable EECS rating throughout this period. Over the past year we have updated our quality system to comply with the ISO9001:2000 standards. In August 2003, we received our ATEX Quality Certification for equipment intended for use in potentially explosive atmospheres, which was granted by CSA/KEMA. This was based on our updated ISO9001:2000 quality system. In June 2004, our processes and manufacturing procedures were successfully audited enabling us to maintain our 3A Certification for Sanitary and Food Grade Probes.

We have Company wide goals and measures for continuous improvement. Training is also an important part of continuous improvement and we have specific training goals for every Associate. Every Associate has completed ISO9001:2000 Quality System Training.

As of May 2009, our Quality System has been reviewed and updated to meet the new requirements as specified in the ISO 9001:2008 standard.

In February 2012, we have been issued a 3rd party certification by Inmetro, which follows the guidelines of ISO 9001:2008 standard and allows for the Brazilian Conformity Marking.

In September 2012, we made the necessary adjustments to the Quality System to meet the new requirements of ISO/IEC 80079-34, which will be replacing the ATEX EN13980 standard. This is basically a duplication of the ISO9001:2008 standard with some additional requirements in certain clauses of the standard.

In July 2013, we elected to change to DNV to perform both the ATEX and the IECEx Audits in our Michigan Facilities. We now have the current QAN and QAR approved by DNV.

For the safety of our customers and employees, our company has an internal policy to prevent the use of CFC containing substances in the manufacture of our products.

In April 2016, we released the new version of the quality system under the 9001:2015 standards.

The following excerpts are from our *Quality Assurance System Manual*.

QUALITY SYSTEM LAYOUT AND CONTROLLED COPY RECORD

The Quality System Documentation consists of five levels; the Company Policy (level one), the Quality Policies Manual (level two), Quality Procedures (level three), Work Instructions (level four) and Records (level five). Supplemental to these documents is the Inspection and Test Plans and Master Lists.

LEVEL I Company Policy – A documented Policy Statement

LEVEL II Quality Policies Manual – The Quality Policies Manual establishes requirements and guidelines for the overall Quality System objectives. These requirements and guidelines are applicable to the operations at **Ametek (APT)**.

LEVEL III Quality Procedures – The Quality Procedures Manual is a collection of Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's), which are documented in conformance with, and support of the Quality Policies Manual's requirements and guidelines. The Quality Procedures Manual details the implementation of requirements and guidelines for the operation. (Quality Procedures are placed as hard copies at relevant workstations).

LEVEL IV Work Instructions – Work Instructions are documented as necessary to support each applicable Quality Procedure. They detail **specific** quality or inspection information and **specific instructions** for performance of individual tasks.

LEVEL V Records – Completed forms provide the objective evidence of compliance.
